

Call for Papers: TLS XIV

The Fourteenth Meeting of the *Texas Linguistic Society* will take place November 1-3, 2013 at the University of Texas at Austin. The organizers invite papers from all subfields of linguistics. There will also be a special session entitled *The Morpho-Semantic Interface*.

Presentations will be 20 minutes in length, with 10 minutes for questions and discussion.

Abstract guidelines:

Length: Maximum 500 words. A second page may include examples, charts, diagrams, and references. Times New Roman, 12-point font is preferred.

Format: Include the paper title and the text of the abstract. The abstract should not include the author's name, affiliation, or other identifying information. All abstracts will be reviewed anonymously.

Extended deadline: June 30, 2013

Notification: July 15, 2013

How to submit: Abstracts should be attached to an email as a PDF file and submitted electronically. Include the following information in the body of the email:

- Author's name
- Author's affiliation
- Paper title
